Presentations/Project Awareness

- Clan Lab Awareness Training – Conklin Volunteer Fire Dept. – presented information to volunteer firefighters and EMT’s about Lourdes MPAD Project and efforts to educate the community. **(21 people)**
- Southern Tier Methamphetamine Prevention Task Force Meeting – presented information to community and professionals about Lourdes MPAD Project resulting in notice of press conference in Press & Sun-Bulletin and to assess their community coordination efforts. **(22 people)**
- Scheduled trainings for Chenango Forks School District **(9/06)**, Lourdes at Home Staff **(6/06)**, and School Guidance Counselors and Social Workers **(10/06)**
- Presented information and did education awareness at Lourdes Employee Wellness Fair (**427 people**)
- Broome-Tioga BOCES Chief Officers Meeting – Presented information on Lourdes MPAD Project, the signs and symptoms of children living in methamphetamine environments, what adult users may act like, and NYS regulations regarding mandated reporters and training around clandestine methamphetamine lab awareness. **(17 school superintendents from Broome and Tioga Counties)**
