**RESOLUTION OF THE BROOME COUNTY LEGISLATURE TO ELECT A ONE-WEEK CLOTHING EXEMPTION FOR 1999 AND 2000**

BE IT ENACTED, by the Legislature of the County of Broome as follows:

Section One. Receipts from sales of and consideration given or contracted to be given for purchases of clothing and footwear exempt from state sales and compensating use taxes pursuant to paragraph 30-a of subdivision (a) of Section 1115 of the tax law shall also be exempt from sales and compensating use taxes imposed in this jurisdiction.

Section Two. This resolution shall take effect immediately and shall apply to sales made and uses occurring during the period commencing September 1, 1999 and ending September 7, 1999 and during the period commencing January 15, 2000 and ending January 21, 2000, as the case may be, although made or occurring under a prior contract.

**Carried**, Ayes-16, Nays-0, Absent-3 (Burger, Hull, Sweet).
