WHAT TO DO WITH THESE WASTES?

*****Keep them separate from debris and garbage*****

Household Haz. Waste

KEEP THESE SEPARATE:

- Paints/Thinners and strippers
- Pesticides
- Automotive fluids
- Hobby chemicals
- Cleaning products
- Batteries/Acids/Bases
- Fluorescent bulbs

Electronic Waste

KEEP THESE SEPARATE:

- TVs
- Computers (desk top and laptop)
- Monitors/Keyboards/Printers
- Video game consoles
- DVD players/Stereos
- Cable and Satellite receivers
- Fax Machines/Scanners
