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**SAFETY TIPS**

1. Stay away from any large drums. Report their location to Stream Captain and proper authorities.
2. Wear gloves to collect debris. Ask volunteers if they have allergies to latex products. \*\*\*Read aloud allergy precaution info (attached).
3. Stay out of unsafe areas and be cautious on steep slopes. Do not wade in open waters to retrieve debris. Do not disturb construction staging areas/equipment. Keep off residential properties, if possible.
4. Handle glass, syringes, and other sharp objects with extreme caution. If available, use screw-top bottle or can with lid to collect small sharps. Use sturdy plastic bag to collect broken glass.
5. Do not lift heavy items without help. Do not dig items out of sediment or banks. You increase your risk of injury when doing so.
6. Be alert for poison ivy, thorny plants, and insect nests in vegetated areas and near debris piles.
7. Try not to disturb wildlife habitats and nesting areas. Avoid contact with wildlife for your safety and theirs. Report any entangled animals (dead or alive) to authorities.
