



Broome County Adult Homes

Adult homes provide 5 or more residents with rooms, meals, help with daily living and some degree of protective supervision.

A resident can also receive assistance with self administration of medications. This is a lower level of care than nursing homes. When considering an adult home for yourself or a family member, an assessment is recommended as a first step. This in-home assessment is at no cost and will determine if this level of care is appropriate. Respite beds, for when a caregiver needs a break, are indicated where they are available.

These homes are licensed and monitored by the NYS Department of Health. Their website can answer a number of questions regarding this level of care by going to their home page and clicking on “Long Term Care” and then “Assisted Living”.
