



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Countywide Value of Construction in 2015: New Residential Construction




















Countywide Construction Value in 2015: New Non-Residential Construction and AA&R





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
Countywide New Residential Building Activity: Five-Year Trend




Countywide New Residential Value: Five-Year Trend




Countywide New Non-Residential Building Activity: Five-Year Trend
