#40 RESOLUTION ADOPTING LOCAL LAW INTRO. NO 3 OF 2021, ENTITLED: "A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 257 OF THE BROOME COUNTY CHARTER AND CODE"

Mr. Pasquale expressed concerns regarding the expiration of the Traffic Diversion Program and the operation of it without authorization by the District Attorney.

Mr. Korchak stated that he believed his office had requested reauthorization in May 2020.

At the request of Mr. Reynolds, Mr. Martin stated that a Local Law was submitted near the beginning of the pandemic, but that it only dealt with technical changes that had been approved in the 2020 budget to bring the Traffic Diversion Program from an off-ledger account to an onbudget account. He further stated that the request did not include an extension of the program. Due to the requirement of the Executive to hold a public hearing the Administration decided to put the request on hold until the Administration came to a determination on how to meet the public hearing requirement.
