## MECHANIC'S HELPER

**DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:** An incumbent in this class is responsible for the performance of semi-skilled work in the repair and maintenance of automotive equipment. Incumbent may independently perform minor repair work but usually work is performed under direct supervision of a higher level mechanic. This class generally works second and third shifts, without supervision, doing equipment lubrication and routine upkeep, and also acts as watchman. Does related work as required.

## TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

Repairs flat tires; Changes and rotates tires; Replaces worn or faulty parts, including gaskets, spark plugs, windshield wipers and lightbulbs; Dismantles, cleans and assembles parts of motors; Washes, greases and changes oil in automotive equipment; Charges batteries; Pumps gasoline; May occasionally operate trucks and automobiles.

## FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Working knowledge of the common practices, tools, terminology and safety precautions associated with the automotive mechanics trade; Ability to follow oral and written instructions; Mechanical aptitude; Physical strength and agility; Physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.
