

Child Passenger Safety Education

Before receiving your seat, you must watch the provided educational video online and complete a 10-question survey.

Once completed, you will be set-up with a hands-on appointment to receive your seat.

Hands-On Appointments

- Must arrive in the vehicle the car seat will be installed in. No cabs, buses, or other forms of public transportation.
- Child receiving seat and parent/guardian of child must be present at the time of the appointment. We cannot distribute car seats to caseworkers, friends, or family members.
- Expecting parents must be in their last trimester.

BROOME COUNTY TRAFFIC SAFETY PROGRAM FREE CHILD SAFETY SEAT EDUCATION AND DISTRIBUTION PROGRAM

This program is designed to **educate** parents and caregivers about the proper ways to transport children safely using child safety seats and seat belts and provide appropriate seats to income eligible families. **We cannot accommodate emergency situations.** Seats are provided by a grant from the NYS Governor's Traffic Safety Committee.

Eligibility for a Free Seat

Parents/caregivers must currently be receiving WIC or Public Assistance and can provide proof of such services. (WIC ID, Medicaid Card, etc.)

Must watch the required online educational video and complete a survey before receiving the child safety seat.

Must participate in a hands-on appointment with a Certified Child Passenger Safety Technician and demonstrate how to properly install the new seat.
