

IMPRES Battery Recovery Procedure:

For batteries that have been in storage a long time – and not properly maintained - when put into an IMPRES charger, if the status LED is blinking RED (which is an error/fault condition), it may be possible to recover some of these batteries with this procedure:

The charger flashing red LED indicates a fault condition. MSI recommends leaving the batteries in the charger overnight (at least 12 hours). If the batteries are still flashing Red after overnight or the 12 hour period, remove the battery from the pocket for 5 seconds and place it back into the pocket for another 12 hours. The charger may be able to recover (fully charge and calibrate) some of the batteries successfully. If this recovery process fails, the batteries were allowed to discharge too deeply to recover and are not useable.

It's impossible to predict whether a battery can be recovered - it depends so much on the batteries and storage conditions.
