**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE YWCA FOR FUNDING FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH'S OPIOID SETTLEMENT – HEALTH PROGRAM GRANT FOR 2026-2027**

WHEREAS, this County Legislature by Resolution 445 of 2022 authorized acceptance of an Opioid Settlement – Health Program Grant for the Department of Health and adopted a program budget in the amount of \$817,962 for the period November 17, 2022 through December 31, 2029, and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Health requests authorization for an agreement with the YWCA for funding from the Opioid Settlement – Health Program Grant in the amount of \$177,000 for the period May 21, 2026 through May 20, 2027, and

WHEREAS, said funding will be used for architectural design and the fire suppression system for the Code Blue Comfort Center at 15 Doubleday Street, Binghamton, New York, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that this County Legislature hereby authorizes an agreement with the YWCA, 80 Hawley Street, Binghamton, New York 13901 for funding in the amount of \$177,000 from the Opioid Settlement – Health Program Grant for the period May 21, 2026 through May 20, 2027, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the payments hereinabove authorized shall be made from budget line 25010004.6004146.1011.2510678 (Subcontracted Program Expense), and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized representative is hereby empowered to execute any such agreements, documents, or papers, approved as to form by the Department of Law, as may be necessary to implement the intent and purpose of this Resolution.
