RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING REVISION OF THE SAFE STREETS AND ROADS FOR ALL (SS4A) PROGRAMS GRANT FOR THE BINGHAMTON METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION STUDY AND ADOPTING A REVISED PROGRAM BUDGET IN CONNECTION THEREWITH FOR 2024-2026

WHEREAS, this County Legislature, by Resolution 584 of 2023, authorized and approved renewal of the Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Program Grant for the Binghamton Metropolitan Transportation Study and adopted a program budget in connection therewith in the total amount of \$600,000 for the period April 1, 2024 through October 1, 2025, and

WHEREAS, said program funding will be used to develop a comprehensive safety action plan, and conduct demonstration activities to inform the development of the action plan using materials such as paint and plastic delineators to experiment with a mini-roundabout to replace all all-way stop controlled intersections, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary at this time to revise said program to reflect a decrease in the amount of \$2,000 in grant appropriations, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that this County Legislature hereby authorizes a revision of the Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Program Grant to reflect an decrease of \$ 2,000 for the period July 8, 2024 through June 30, 2026, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that this County Legislature hereby approves and adopts the revised program budget annexed hereto as Exhibit "A" in the total amount of \$598,000, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that Resolution 584 of 2023, to the extent consistent herewith, shall remain in full force and effect, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized representative is hereby authorized to execute any such agreements, documents or papers, approved as to form by the Department of Law, as may be necessary to implement the intent and purpose of this Resolution, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized representative is hereby empowered (with the approval of the grantor agency) to reduce the time period of the grant provided there is no change in the grant budget or extend the terms of the grant agreement for the purpose of expending any unexpended grant funds, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized representative (including the Budget Director, Comptroller and/or Commissioner of Finance) is hereby authorized to make any transfers of funds within this grant budget provided that employee head count is not increased, the County's contribution is not increased, and the salary rate or salary total for a position is not changed.
