#49 RESOLUTION ADOPTING LOCAL LAW INTRO. NO. 6 OF 2024, ENTITLED: "A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 257-40 OF THE BROOME COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE"

Mr. Flagg wanted to know the rationale behind the \$750/day fee for a full-day single field rental and the \$2,500/season for school districts at the softball complex. He would also like to see a utilization report for the complex.
