**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH RELYUS HEALTH PROS LLC TO PROVIDE TEMPORARY HEALTHCARE STAFFING SERVICES FOR THE WILLOW POINT REHABILITATION AND NURSING CENTER FOR 2022-2023**

WHEREAS, a State of Emergency Declaration was declared for the Willow Point Rehabilitation and Nursing Center due to operational challenges and staffing shortages exacerbated by the COVID-19 pandemic, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the State of Emergency declaration, the requirements of section A1202 of the Broome County Charter and Code are waived to permit Willow Point Nursing Home to enter into contracts with temporary employment services for Registered Nurses, Licensed Practical Nurses, and Certified Nurse Assistants, and

WHEREAS, the Administrator of the Willow Point Rehabilitation and Nursing Center requests authorization for an agreement with, Relyus Health Pros LLC to provide temporary healthcare staffing services at a cost not to exceed \$500,000, for the period October 20, 2022 through October 19, 2023, with the option for two one-year renewals under the same terms and conditions, and

WHEREAS, said agreement is necessary to have adequate staff to maintain the quality of living for the residents of the Nursing Home, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that this County Legislature hereby authorizes an agreement with, Relyus Health Pros LLC, 90 State Street, Suite 700, Office 40, Albany, NY 12207 to provide temporary healthcare staffing services for the Willow Point Rehabilitation and Nursing Center, at the rates attached on Exhibit "A" for the period October 20, 2022 through October 19, 2023, with the option for two one-year renewals under the same terms and conditions, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that in consideration of said services, the County shall pay the Contractors an aggregate amount not to exceed \$500,000 for the term of the agreement, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the payments hereinabove authorized shall be made from budget line 27060304.6004410.2050 (Nursing Services), and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized representative is hereby empowered to execute any such agreements, documents, or papers, approved as to form by the Department of Law, as may be necessary to implement the intent and purpose of this Resolution.

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF NEW YORK STATE UPSTATE AIRPORT  
REVITALIZATION COMPETITION PROGRAM FUNDING FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF  
AVIATION'S TERMINAL REHABILITATION PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Aviation requests authorization to accept New York State Upstate Airport Revitalization Competition Program funding at an amount up to \$32,000,000 for the Department of Aviation's Terminal Rehabilitation Project, and

WHEREAS the County of Broome desires to advance the Project by committing anticipated funds for the local match, the anticipated funding shares being: State: \$32,000,000, Federal: \$3,750,000, Local: \$4,080,000 for a Project total of \$39,830,000, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that this County Legislature hereby authorizes and approves acceptance of up to \$32,000,000 from New York State for the Department of Aviation's Terminal Rehabilitation Project, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized representative is hereby empowered to execute any such agreements, documents, or papers, approved as to form by the Department of Law, as may be necessary to implement the intent and purpose of this Resolution, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized representative is hereby empowered (with the approval of the grantor agency) to reduce the time period of the grant provided there is no change in the grant budget or extend the terms of the grant agreement for the purpose of expending any unexpended grant funds, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that a Certified copy of this Resolution be filed with the New York State Commissioner of Transportation by attaching it to any necessary Agreement in connection with the Project, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized representative (including the Director of Management and Budget and/or Comptroller) is hereby authorized to make any transfers of funds required within this grant budget provided that employee head count is not increased, the County's contribution is not increased, and the salary rate or salary total for a position is not changed.

**RESOLUTION ADOPTING LOCAL LAW INTRO. NO. 4 OF 2022, ENTITLED: "A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 257-40 AND 317-9 OF THE BROOME COUNTY CHARTER AND CODE"**

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Public Works, Parks, Recreation and Youth Services has proposed in the 2023 Budget changes to Parks and Recreation fees, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Aviation has proposed in the 2023 Budget changes to Airport fees, and

WHEREAS, the Director of Solid Waste Management has proposed in the 2023 Budget to add a new fee of \$20 for uncovered loads, and

WHEREAS, the Director of Solid Waste Management has requested changes to Section 317-9 of the Broome County Charter and Code, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that Local Law Intro. No. 4 of 2022, entitled: "A Local Law Amending Chapter 257-40 of the Broome County Charter and Code", be and the same hereby is adopted and approved in accordance with the Broome County Charter and Administrative Code and all the applicable statutes and laws pertaining thereto.

**LOCAL LAW INTRO. NO. 4 of 2022**

"A Local Law Amending Chapter 257-40 of the Broome County Charter and Code"

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Broome as follows:

Section 1 Chapter 257-40 Airport is amended as follows:
