WHEREAS, this County Legislature, by Resolution 303 of 2023, authorized and approved renewal of the Pre-Trial Release Program Grant for the Department of Probation and adopted a program budget in the amount of \$160,232.66 for the period July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024, and
