**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH LONG TERM CARE SOLUTIONS OF NY LLC TO ASSUME THE ROLE OF ADMINISTRATOR OF RECORD AT THE WILLOW POINT REHABILITATION AND NURSING CENTER FOR 2024**

WHEREAS, the Board of Acquisition and Contract, on November 7, 2024, by CA #17-725-1, authorized an agreement with Long Term Care Solutions of NY LLC to assume the role of Administrator of Record at the Willow Point Rehabilitation and Nursing Center, at the rate of \$350 per hour for fifteen (15) to eighteen (18) hours per week, total cost not to exceed \$14,999 for the period November 8, 2024 through November 22, 2024, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to authorize the amendment of said agreement to increase the not to exceed amount by \$285,001 and amend the period to a term of 90 days from the contracts execution, which includes the option to renew for an additional three months, upon consent of both parties, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that this County Legislature hereby authorizes an amendment to the agreement with Long Term Care Solutions of NY LLC, 2111 Spaulding Road, Binghamton, NY 13903 to increase the not to exceed amount by \$285,0001 and amend the period to a term of 90 days from the contracts execution, which includes the option to renew for an additional three months, upon consent of both parties, to assume the role of Administrator of Record at the Willow Point Rehabilitation and Nursing Center, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that in consideration of said services, the County shall pay the Contractor at the rate of \$350 per hour for fifteen (15) to eighteen (18) hours per week, total cost not to exceed \$300,000, for the term of the agreement, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the payments hereinabove authorized shall be made from budget line 27010104.6004255.2050 (Contracted Services), and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that CA #17-725-1, to the extend consistent herewith, shall remain in full force and effect, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized representative is hereby empowered to execute any such agreements, documents, or papers, approved as to form by the Department of Law, as may be necessary to implement the intent and purpose of this Resolution.
