RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING REVISION OF THE HIGH VISIBILITY ENGAGEMENT CAMPAIGN (HVEC) PROGRAM GRANT FOR THE OFFICE OF THE SHERIFF'S STOP-DWI PROGRAM AND ADOPTING A REVISED PROGRAM BUDGET FOR 2024-2025

WHEREAS, this County Legislature, by Resolution 433 of 2024, authorized and approved the High Visibility Engagement Campaign (HVEC) Program Grant for the Office of the Sheriff's STOP-DWI Program and adopted a program budget in the amount of \$29,000 for the period October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025, and

WHEREAS, said program grant provides for high visibility road checks, saturation patrols and Drug Recognition Expert call out during New York Crackdown dates, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary at this time to revise said program to reflect an increase in the amount of \$2,020.16 in grant appropriations, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that this County Legislature hereby authorizes a revision of the High Visibility Engagement Campaign (HVEC) Program Grant to reflect an increase of \$2,020.16 for the period October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that this County Legislature hereby approves and adopts the revised program budget annexed hereto as Exhibit "A" in the total amount of \$3 1,020.16, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that Resolution 433 of 2024, to the extent consistent herewith, shall remain in full force and effect, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized representative is hereby authorized to execute any such agreements, documents or papers, approved as to form by the Department of Law, as may be necessary to implement the intent and purpose of this Resolution, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized representative is hereby empowered (with the approval of the grantor agency) to reduce the time period of the grant provided there is no change in the grant budget or extend the terms of the grant agreement for the purpose of expending any unexpended grant funds, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized representative (including the Director of Management and Budget and/or Comptroller) is hereby authorized to make any transfers of funds within this grant budget provided that employee head count is not increased, the County's contribution is not increased, and the salary rate or salary total for a position is not changed.
