

COUNTY ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES
DECEMBER 30, 2025

The County Administration Committee of the Broome County Legislature met on Tuesday, December 30, 2025 in the Legislative Conference Room, Sixth Floor, Edwin L. Crawford County Office Building.

The Committee meeting was called to order by the Chairman at 4:45 p.m. Mrs. Micha made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Kaminsky, to move the agenda. The Committee took the following action with regard to the matters before it:

#19 RESOLUTION ADOPTING LOCAL LAW INTRO. NO. 7 OF 2025, ENTITLED: LOCAL LAW FOR CANNABIS ENFORCEMENT

Responding to several questions from Legislators, Mr. Akshar explained that is a civil process and he will use existing staff from the Special Investigation Unit to investigate unlicensed activity of cannabis. He further stated that, except for Vestal, the SIU is comprised of other municipal police departments. Violations will go before a hearing officer. The process outlined in the Local Law, including the administration of fines, was recommended by the NYS Sheriff's Association and reviewed by the County Attorney. Any evidence will be recorded in the evidence management system and will be destroyed upon review of the Evidence Custodian.
