#13 RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH THE BC SENATORS, INC., FOR LEASE OF THE VETERANS' MEMORIAL ARENA

Mr. Marion stated that this amendment is just a name change on the contract and to allow the Devils Hockey Team to use Ticketmaster software to manage their season ticket holder program, which they will have responsibility for that cost.

#46 RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN INTERMUNICIPAL AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWN OF CONKLIN FOR FUNDING FROM THE BROWNFIELD REMEDIATION ALLOCATION OF THE OCCUPANCY TAX FOR 2019

Mr. Dumian stated that the Town of Conklin has been very interested in putting in Community Center, which would double as a Red Cross Emergency Shelter in the event of a natural disaster. In addition to the Town's Center, the building will house a childcare facility and possibly a healthcare clinic, both of which Lourdes Hospital would operate. The Town is requesting assistance from the County for this endeavor due to budget shortfalls, which are due to an under estimation of costs by their construction manager. The facility will be built in the Broome Corporate Park in Conklin.
