

AD HOC COMMITTEE ON REDISTRICTING MEETING MINUTES

The Ad Hoc Committee on Redistricting of the Broome County Legislature met remotely on Tuesday, November 30, 2021 via Zoom Videoconferencing.

- Staff will work to make Zoom meeting details consistent going forward for regular meetings.
