April 25, 2022

Attached is a summary of proposals made by both the Broome County and ATU negotiating teams that have been tentatively agreed to.

If agreed upon by a majority vote of the ATU members, a tentative agreement would be signed by both parties and then a final agreement will be presented to the legislature for final approval.

**Article 6.02** (BC #7 re-written )

Original Language:

The decision as to whether the employee is capable of performing such work shall be solely with the County.

The Union shall be allowed one participant for each management representative. However, the grievant (if there is one) shall be allowed to attend the meeting. ***Management will make every reasonable effort to give Overtime to Full Time Coach Operator or Part Time Coach Operator performing a hold down as outlined in Article 42.09, before offering work to the Part Time Coach Operators for Overtime.***

***Any additional overtime work assignments that become available after the markup period(s), will follow the same procedure.***

***If the Supervisors are unable to assign all pieces of work (overtime). Then the Supervisors will break up any of the pieces of work (runs) and offer overtime to Full Time Coach Operators as follow:***

- ***Any piece of work (run) that is 3 hour 15 minutes or less, the Supervisor will offer the entire piece of overtime to all available Full Time Coach Operators.***

**Article 25 Section 25.07 1st paragraph (new language continued)**

- ***Any pieces of work (run) that is more than 3 hours 15 minutes, the Supervisor will break up the work (run) and offer A-B and C piece to all available Full Time Coach Operators as overtime.***

Employees who have personal need to schedule a doctor's appointment, and due so with forty-eight hours notice, shall not have a 1/2 day absence counted. This shall only be allowed once per quarter.

(c.) Incentive award payments by the County to the employee for each quarter shall be made in the pay period following each quarter by separate check.

(d.) Any Coach Operator with a perfect attendance record - no jumps, no misses and no passes on required work - in a calendar year, shall be entitled in the immediately following calendar year to utilize one week (5 days) of vacation time in single day portions, in accordance with such policies as may be established by the Commissioner of Public Transportation. Perfect shall be defined to mean no absences, sick or as otherwise described above.

**New Language:**

The County agrees to make incentive award payments to eligible full-time **Operators, part-time Operators, Passenger Van Operators, and Maintenance** employees in accordance with the following provisions:

(a.) Each calendar year shall be divided into four (4) quarters: January 1 through March 31, April 1 through June 30, July 1 through September 30, and October 1 through December 31.

**Article 41 Section 41.02** (CP # 43) continued

**New Language:**

(b). An employee who works all scheduled work days during any quarter, exclusive of paid holidays, vacation days, bereavement leave days, jury duty days, and compensation days, shall be entitled to receive for that quarter a bonus award for exemplary attendance equal to eight (8) hours' pay, provided, however, that an employee may use compensation days to qualify as having worked all scheduled work days in a quarter only once in any calendar year. Sick absences of less than one (1) full day shall be counted as (1) absence. Any employee absent from work due to seeing an attending physician or a hearing for a work related injury shall not be disqualified from the attendance incentive program for the quarter. Misses shall count as an absence regardless of the number of eligible days in a quarter, and jumped employees who fail to work shall have an absence counted. Employees who have personal need to schedule a doctor's appointment, and due so with forty-eight hours notice, shall not have a 1/2 day absence counted. This shall only be allowed once per quarter.

Any Coach Operator with a perfect attendance record - no jumps, no misses and no passes on required work - in a calendar year, shall be entitled in the immediately following calendar year to utilize one week (5 days) of vacation time in single day portions, in accordance with such policies as may be established by the Commissioner of Public Transportation. Perfect shall be defined to mean no absences, sick or as otherwise described above.

**Article 42 Section 42.03** (UP # 48)

**Original Language:**

Part-time Coach Operators shall comply with Article 13 of this contract and shall be entitled to the following benefits: life insurance, retirement and worker's compensation and health benefits as set forth in Article 22. Part-time Coach Operators shall be eligible for vacation in the amount of one half that provided to full-time Coach Operators (See Article 8). Additionally, part-time Coach Operators shall be eligible for sick time and floating holidays as provided in Article 23 and Article 9, respectively. Part-time Coach Operators will also be eligible for bereavement leave pursuant to Article 21. To be eligible for these benefits Part-time Coach Operators must be available to work a minimum of 320 hours per quarter.

**Article 42 Section 42.03** (UP # 48) continued

Part-time Coach Operators shall comply with Article 13 of this contract and shall be entitled to the following benefits: life insurance, retirement and worker's compensation and health benefits as set forth in Article 22. Additionally, part-time Coach Operators shall be eligible for sick time and floating holidays as provided in Article 23 and Article 9, **and Attendance Incentive Program as provided in Article 41** respectively. Part-time Coach Operators will also be eligible for bereavement leave pursuant to Article 21.
