



RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A LEASE AND EASEMENT AGREEMENT WITH ABOVE GRID SOLAR LLC FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF AVIATION

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Aviation requests authorization for a lease and easement agreement with Above Grid Solar LLC for the Department of Aviation with a minimum revenue guarantee to the County in the amount of \$30,000 per year, for an initial term commencing on the effective date and expiring on the date that is twenty-five years after the Commercial Operation Date, with the First Due Diligence and Construction period from the Effective Date until the earlier of the Commercial Operation Date or 18 months from the Effective Date, and the Second Due Diligence and Construction Period from the expiration of the first Due Diligence and Construction Period until the earlier of the Commercial Operation Date or 18 months from the expiration of the First Due Diligence and Construction Period, with the option to extend the Initial Term for four additional five year periods, and

WHEREAS, said agreement is necessary for a solar array site on approximately 30 acres of County property, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that this County Legislature hereby authorizes a lease and easement agreement with Above Grid Solar LLC, 516 Route 33, Building 2, Suite 101, Millstone, New Jersey 08535 for the Department of Aviation, for an initial term commencing on the effective date and expiring on the date that is twenty-five years after the Commercial Operation Date, with the First Due Diligence and Construction period from the Effective Date until the earlier of the Commercial Operation Date or 18 months from the Effective Date, and the Second Due Diligence and Construction Period from the expiration of the first Due Diligence and Construction Period until the earlier of the Commercial Operation Date or 18 months from the expiration of the First Due Diligence and Construction Period, with the option to extend the Initial Term for four additional five year periods, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that in consideration of said agreement, the Contractor shall pay the County a minimum of \$30,000 per year for the term of the agreement, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the revenue hereinabove authorized shall be credited to budget line 28010005.5000460, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized representative is hereby empowered to execute any such agreements, documents, or papers, approved as to form by the Department of Law, as may be necessary to implement the intent and purpose of this Resolution.
