In response to questions from the Committee, Ms. Haas stated that the Land Bank is working with the New York Land Bank Association to suggest changes to State law to address the U.S. Supreme Court decision that impacted the tax foreclosure process. The decision has created an issue for Land Banks that often rely on the tax foreclosure process to obtain properties for rehabilitation and demolition. Mr. Martin added that if a property is condemned and determined to be a danger to the community then demolition can likely go forward. Ms. Haas stated that the Land Bank currently has a number of properties already in the rehab "pipeline" so they will not have a lack of projects to tackle while the Supreme Court decision is implemented. Ms. Haas and Mr. Martin further stated that vacant lots created by the demolition of foreclosed properties are disposed of in various ways including selling to neighboring property owners, reuse as community gardens or maintained by a municipality as green space.
