RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING RENEWAL OF THE AGREEMENT WITH VARIOUS PROVIDER AGENCIES FOR SERVICES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES' PURCHASE OF SERVICE PROGRAMS FOR 2024

WHEREAS, this County Legislature, by Resolution 496 of 2022, authorized renewal of the agreements with various provider agencies for services for the Department of Social Services' Purchase of Service Programs at amounts not to exceed \$3,884,668, for the period January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023, and

WHEREAS, said services are necessary for various related to the Department of Social Services' Purchase of Service Programs, and

WHEREAS, said agreement expires by its terms on December 31, 2023, and it is desired at this time to renew said agreement on substantially similar terms and conditions, for an amounts listed in Exhibit "A", total amount not to exceed \$3,253,725, for the period January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024 now, therefore, be it

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Social Services requests authorization to accept and pass through Cost of Living Adjustments (COLA) from New York State to all provider agencies without further Legislative approval, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Social Services requests authorization to adjust, if necessary, without further Legislative approval, the amounts designated between Purchase of Service Programs within specific providers as long as the total amount designated for each provider does not exceed the budget amount, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that this County Legislature hereby authorizes the renewal of the agreement with various provider agencies for various services as listed on Exhibit A for Department of Social Services' Purchase of Services Programs for the period January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that in consideration of said services, the County shall pay the Contractors an amount not to exceed \$3,253,725 for the term of the agreement, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the payments hereinabove authorized shall be made from budget line 35070006.6004400 (Medical and Physical Exams), 35070006.6004300 (Purchase of Services), 35070006.6004315 (Foster Care NS Detention), 35070006.6004326 (EAF/POS), 35070006.6004331 (Raise the Age), 35070006.6004373 (Other Fees for Services), and be it

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FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized representative is hereby empowered to execute any such agreements, documents, or papers, approved as to form by the Department of Law, as may be necessary to implement the intent and purpose of this Resolution.
