The scope of the project increased to include general construction and electrical, which caused the cost to go up. The construction season for the Forum is very short, so the extended period increased pricing as well. Responding to a question from Mr. Hilderbrant, Mr. Marion stated that the new scope of the project requires a complete overhaul of the original system that is over 40 years old.
