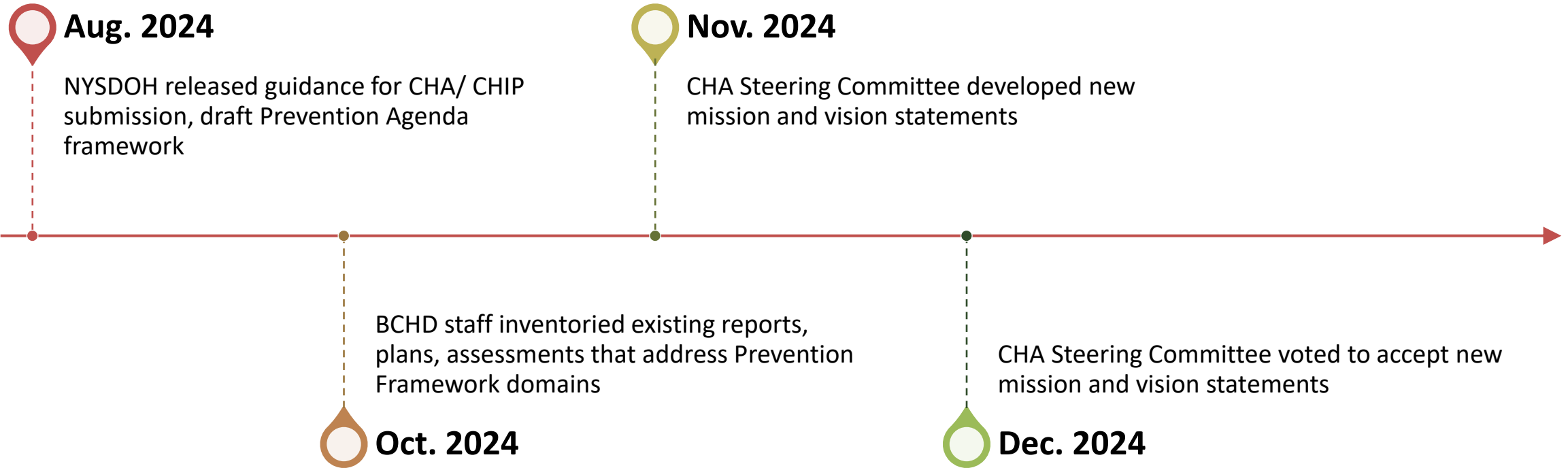


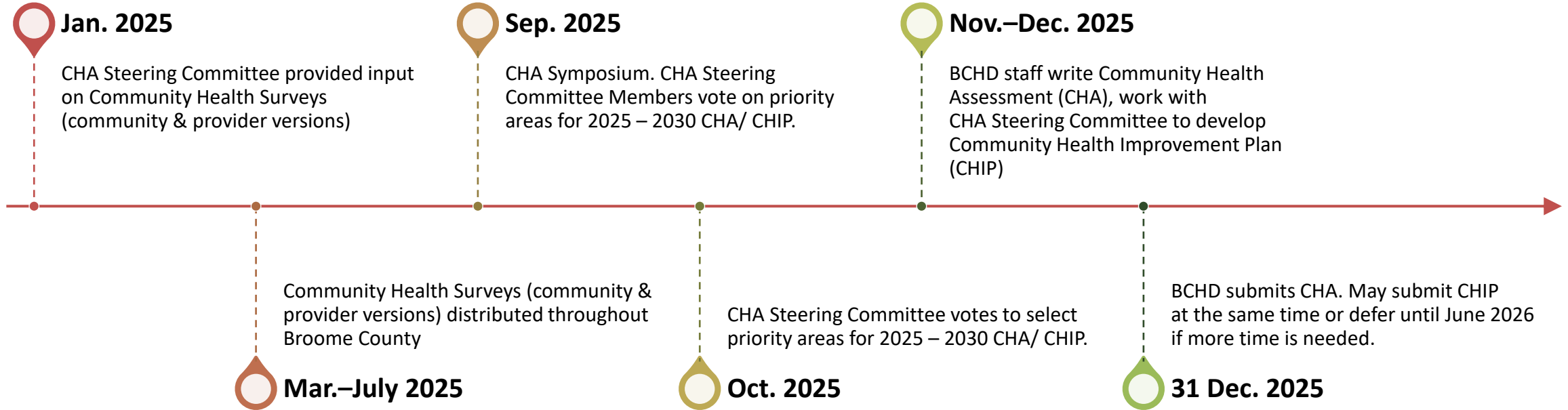

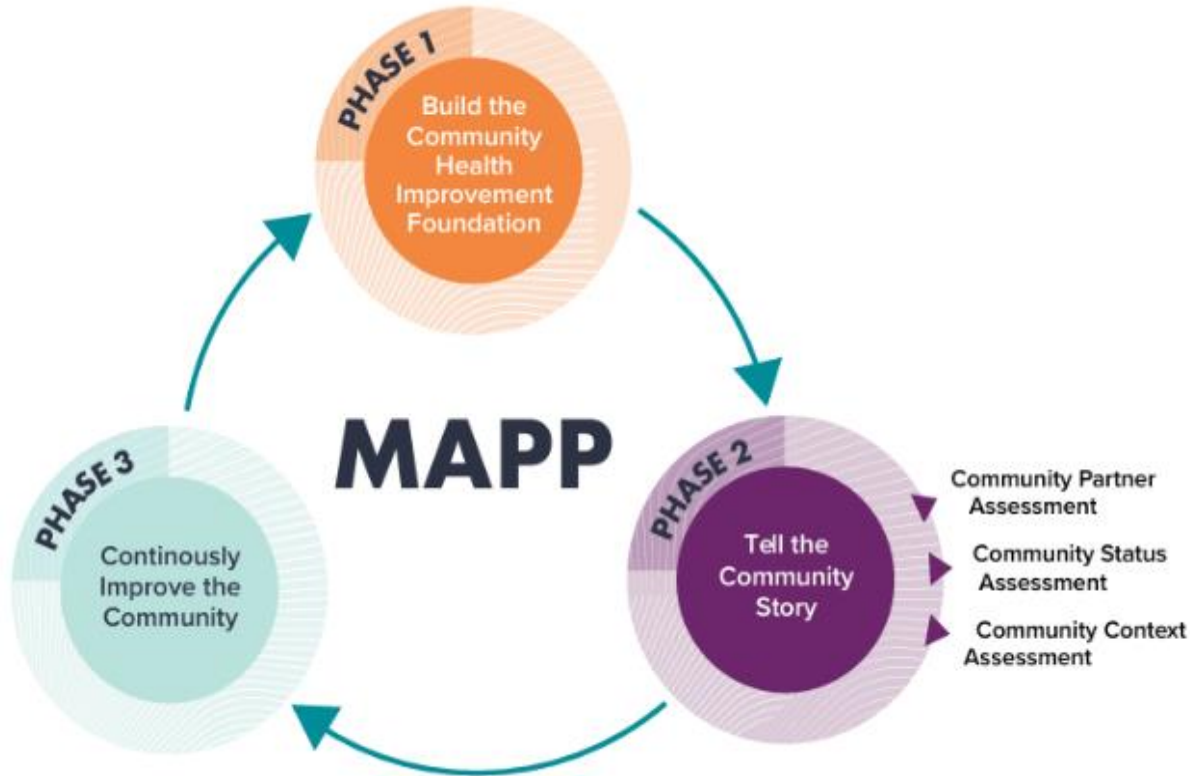

By completing the survey, you can enter to win a \$50 Wells gift card!

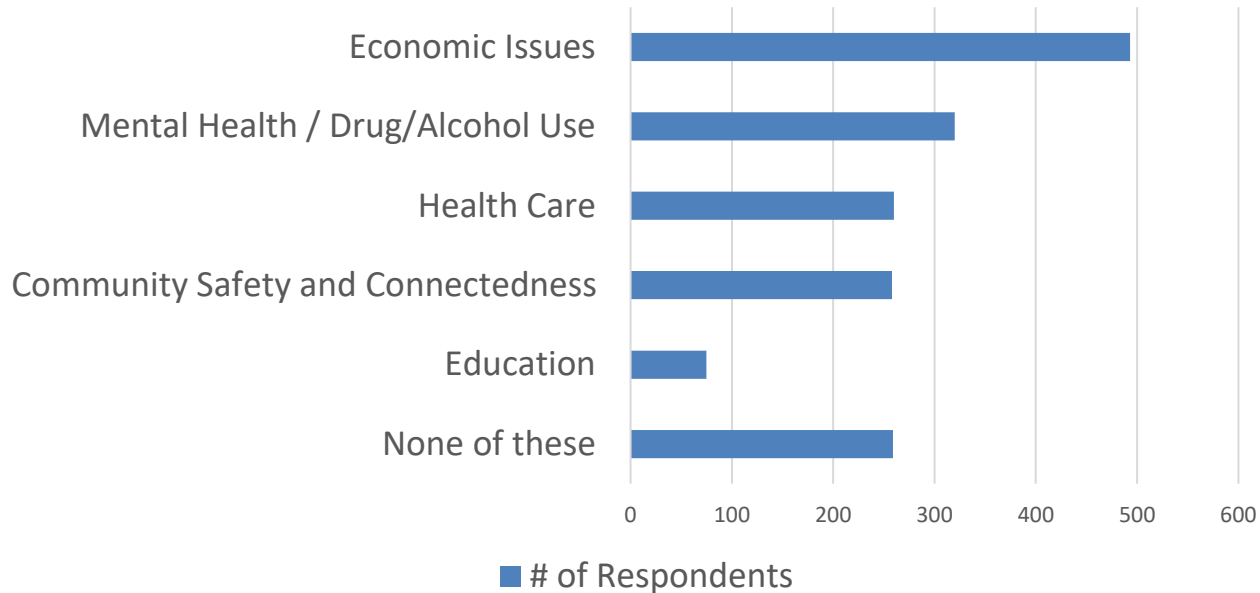

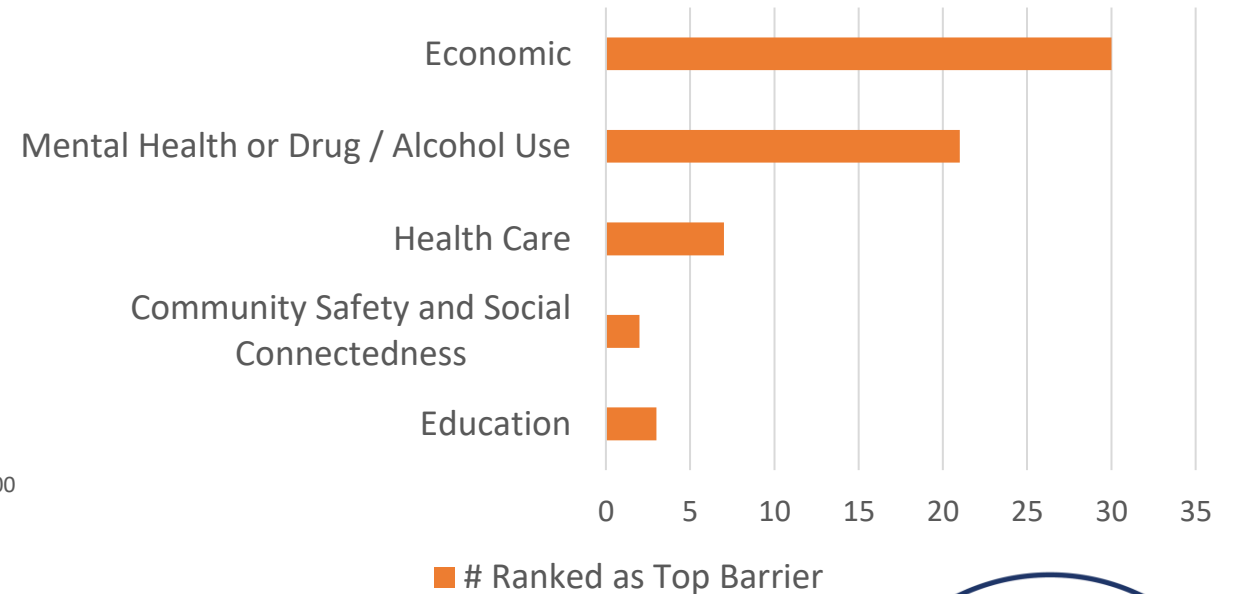


Domains According to Respondents

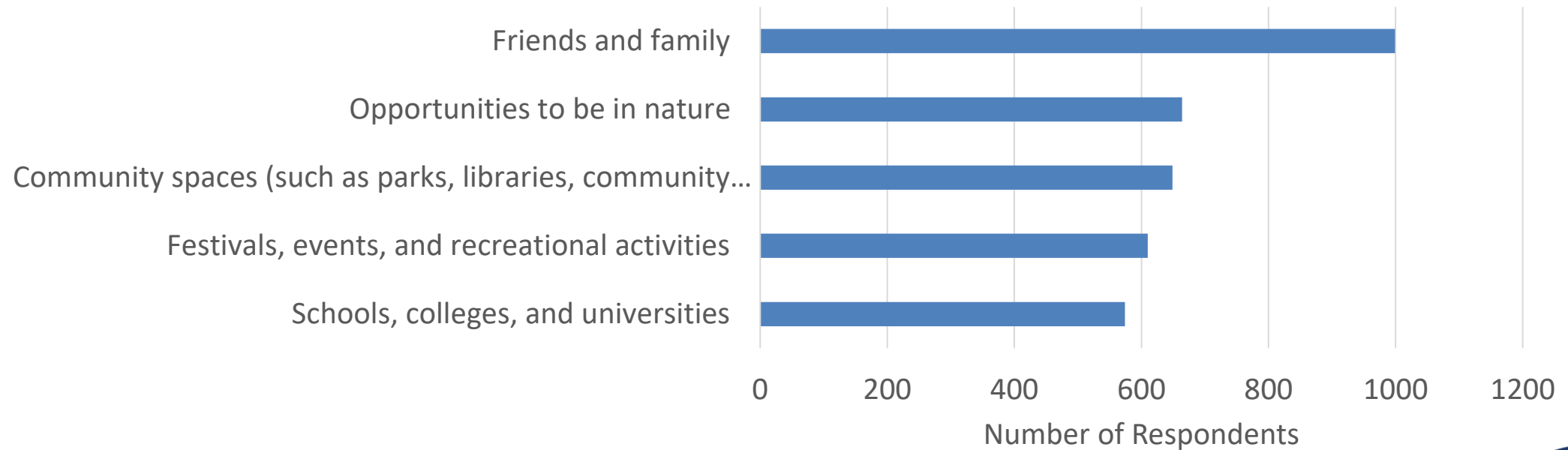
Which one of these is the biggest concern for you personally?

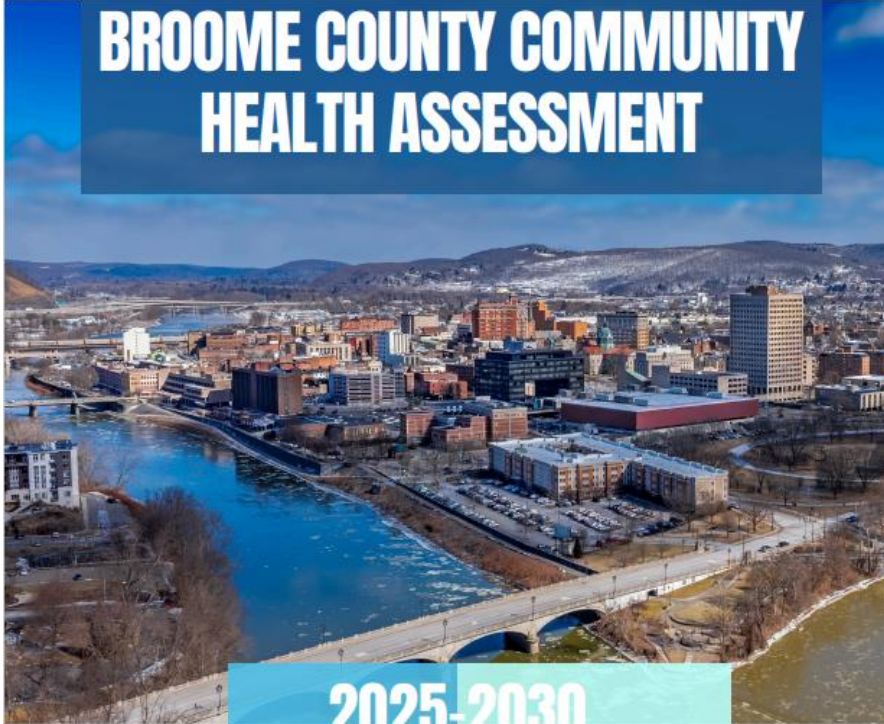

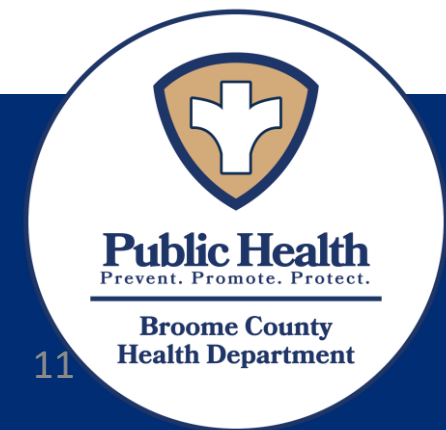

3 Priority Areas for Broome County

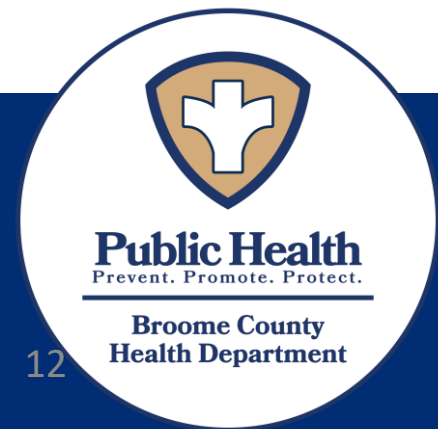
Poverty	Reduce the percentage of people living in poverty by 1.1% Reduce the percentage of people aged 65+ living in poverty by 1.2 %
Anxiety & Stress	Decrease the percentage of adults who experience frequent mental distress 1.4% Decrease the percentage of adults in households with annual income of less than \$25,000 who experience frequent mental distress by 2.1%
Housing	Increase the number of people living in HUD-subsidized housing by about 10% Increase the percentage of adults, with an annual income of less than \$25,000, who were able to pay their mortgage, rent, or utility bills in the past 12 months by 4.3%



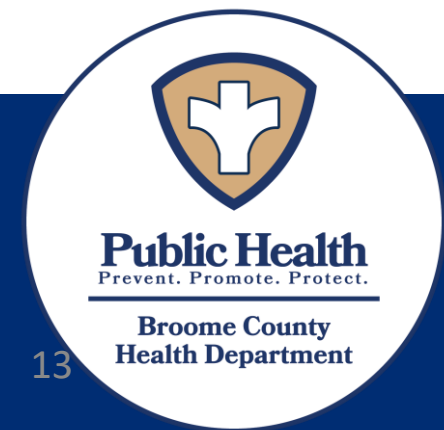
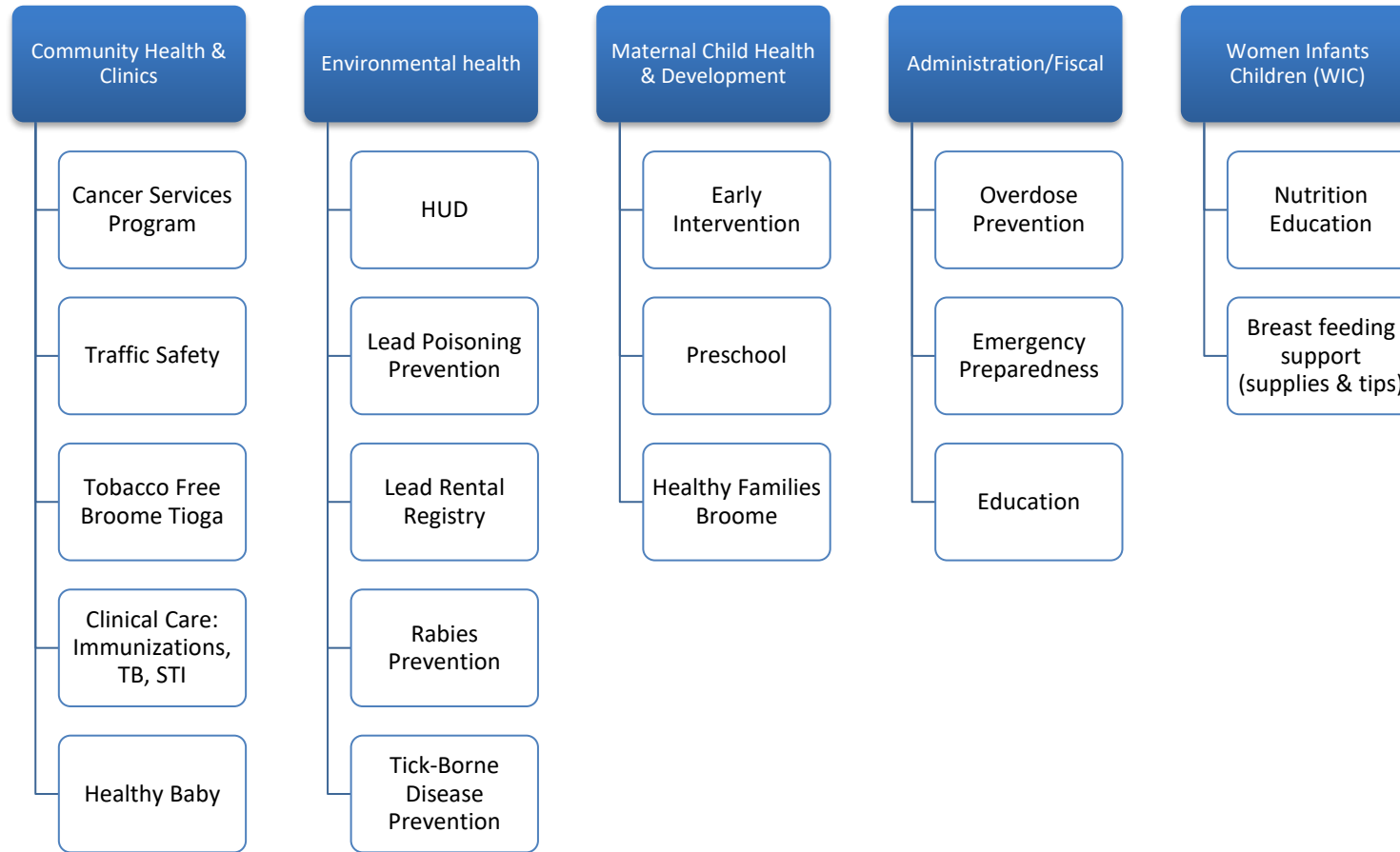
