In addition, with data tracking demonstrating systemic need, Broome has growth in its OMH housing opportunities under development.

Goal 1, 2027 Status Update: Not started

Goal 1, 2027 Status Update Description: Housing continues to be a prominent community priority. The Community Services Board and each of its Subcommittees will provide ongoing opportunities to share information, discuss emerging housing needs, and provide updates on housing resources and initiatives. Housing resource mapping for both OMH- and OASAS-funded services will continue, building upon the existing OASAS housing mapping document and expanding it to create a more comprehensive community resource inventory. Additionally, a dedicated workgroup will be established to cultivate and strengthen relationships with landlords who provide housing to individuals served by the behavioral health system. The workgroup will also develop strategies to offer education, support, and collaboration to increase housing opportunities and promote successful tenancies.

Goal 1 Objective 1, 2027 Status Update Description: Based on feedback from the Community Services Board and its Subcommittees, the original scope exceeded the capacity of participating stakeholders. The revised objectives prioritizes activities that can be effectively advanced with available resources while continuing to support the overarching goal of improving the local behavioral health system. Updates reflect this strategic shift and the Board's commitment to pursuing meaningful, achievable progress.

In addition, the Community Services Board and its Subcommittees will continue to provide dedicated time for information sharing, resource exchange, and collaborative discussions that support and strengthen the behavioral health workforce.

Additionally, the Broome County Mental Health Department's System of Care Dashboard will be expanded to include a comprehensive repository of cross-system resources, program information, and training opportunities. The repository will be enhanced with searchable functionality to improve accessibility, support navigation of available services, and promote greater understanding of programs and resources across systems.

Goal 3 Objective 1, 2027 Status Update: Ongoing

Goal 3 Objective 1, 2027 Status Update Description: Updates regarding cross-system services and supports were provided regularly during Community Services Board and Subcommittee meetings, consistent with the intent of this objective. These discussions facilitated information sharing among stakeholders and addressed topics including emerging system needs, regulatory considerations, service coordination, and programmatic impacts across behavioral health and partner systems. Based on feedback received during the Community Services Board and Subcommittee planning process, this objective will continue to operationalize cross-system collaboration and align implementation activities with current priorities and available resources.

Goal 4

Goal 4, 2027 Status Update: Ongoing

Goal 4, 2027 Status Update Description: The Community Services Board and its Subcommittees continue to identify crisis services as a community priority. To support this priority, each Board and Subcommittee meeting will include dedicated time for information sharing, education, and updates related to the local crisis continuum. In addition, the current crisis system will be reviewed to identify service availability, gaps, and opportunities for enhanced coordination. A multidisciplinary workgroup will be established to develop a comprehensive map of crisis services, creating a clear and accessible inventory of programs, eligibility criteria, referral pathways, and service capacity to strengthen system navigation and improve access to care.

Goal 4 Objective 1, 2027 Status Update: Ongoing

Goal 4 Objective 1, 2027 Status Update Description: The existing Naloxone, medication disposal, and harm reduction resource map continues to serve as a valuable community resource. The map will be maintained and regularly updated to ensure it reflects current programs, locations, and services, supporting timely access to harm reduction resources and promoting community awareness.

Goal 4 Objective 2, 2027 Status Update: Ongoing

Goal 4 Objective 2, 2027 Status Update Description: A multidisciplinary workgroup has been established to map the continuum of crisis services available within the community, creating a comprehensive inventory of programs, eligibility criteria, referral pathways, and service capacity to improve coordination, system navigation, and access to care.

Goal 4 Objective 3, 2027 Status Update Description: Data collection has been discussed and actively encouraged through the Community Services Board and its Subcommittees as part of ongoing system planning and improvement efforts. In partnership with the Local Government Unit (LGU), all contracted providers contribute required programmatic data to support system monitoring and evaluation. In addition, several agencies have initiated supplemental data collection beyond contractual requirements to further inform emerging system needs and service trends.

This data, along with other relevant system information, will be incorporated into the Crisis Services Mapping Workgroup to support the development of a comprehensive and accurate inventory of crisis services, identify service gaps, and enhance cross-system coordination and planning.
