


Hawkins Pond Cross Country Ski Trails



Welcome to Winter at Hawkins Pond!

Looking for a wilderness ski experience? Broome County Parks' Hawkins Pond Nature Area, and the adjacent New York State Hawkins Pond State Forest, offer a combined 6.75 miles of ski trails for beginners to experts.

These ungroomed trails provide an opportunity to ski in a wilderness setting, with several points of interest and much natural beauty along the way.

There is no charge to ski on these trails, and equipment rentals are not available. Trails are open daylight hours.

- Stay on the trails
- Yield to the right when being passed

With over 6.5 miles of scenic trails covering a breathtaking variety of white-frosted landscapes, Greenwood Park offers cross-country skiing and snowshoeing. This is an excellent opportunity for all to experience true beauty and solitude during the winter season.

Location

All Trails begin and end at the Park Office Ski Concession

Equipment

- Bring your own equipment and purchase a daily or seasonal trail pass at Park Office
 - Rent skiing/snowshoeing equipment at the Parks Office.
- No trail pass required!

9:00am-4:00pm Weekends

\$10 Rental Per Hour
\$10 Trail Fee Per Day (Non-Renters)
\$40 Season Pass

Safety

- Ski with a partner
- Stay on the groomed trails
- Yield to the right when passed
- Dogs are not permitted on ski trails at anytime
- Hiking is not permitted on ski trails
