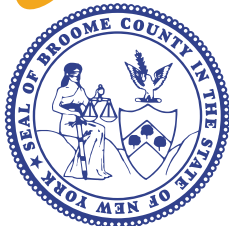

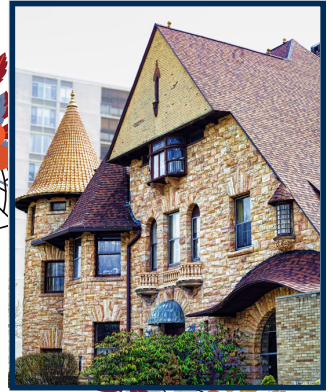
HISTORIC FLORAL PARK CEMETERY GUIDED WALKING TOUR

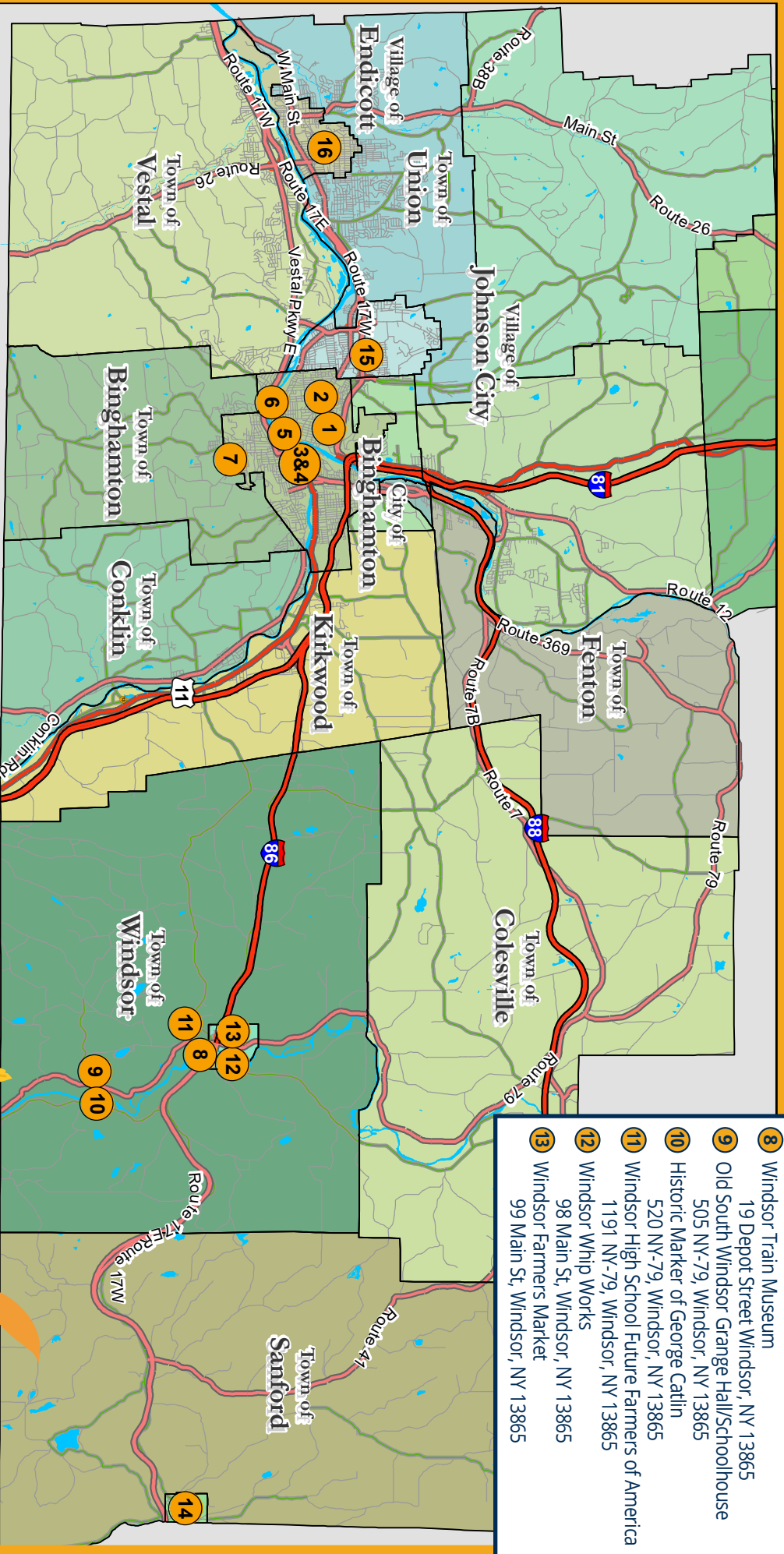
