




## **Countywide Permits Issued in 2008: New Residential Construction**




## Countywide Value of Construction in 2008: New Residential Construction




## **Countywide Construction Value in 2008: New Residential Construction and AA&R**




# **Countywide Permits Issued in 2008: New Non-Residential Construction**




## Countywide Value of Construction in 2008: New Non-Residential Construction




### Countywide Construction Value in 2008: New Non-Residential Construction and AA&R




### Countywide Permits Issued in 2008: Total Residential and Non-Residential Construction




### Countywide Construction Value in 2008: Total Residential and Non-Residential Construction




### Countywide New Residential Building Activity: Five-Year Trend




### **Countywide New Residential Value: Five-Year Trend**




### Countywide New Non-Residential Building Activity: Five-Year Trend
