




Countywide Permits Issued in 2014: New Residential Construction




Countywide Value of Construction in 2014: New Residential Construction




Countywide Construction Value in 2014: New Residential Construction and AA&R




Countywide Construction Value in 2014: New Non-Residential Construction and AA&R




Countywide Permits Issued in 2014: Total Residential and Non-Residential Construction




Countywide Construction Value in 2014: Total Residential and Non-Residential Construction




Countywide New Residential Building Activity: Five-Year Trend




Countywide New Residential Value: Five-Year Trend




Countywide New Non-Residential Building Activity: Five-Year Trend
