Should the bidder exceed the aforementioned 4%, the County will make necessary adjustment to determine the correct amount bid based upon the arithmetically correct proposal.

NOTE: UPON NOTIFICATION OF AWARD OF CONTRACT, THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER MAY BE REQUIRED TO SUBMIT IN WRITING A BREAKDOWN OF THE FOREGOING UNIT PRICES INDICATING (A) WHAT PORTION IS FOR MATERIALS AND SUPPLIES AND (B) WHAT PORTION IS FOR OTHER CONSIDERATIONS.

BID SUBMITTAL AND BID BOND:

Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope, clearly marked with the words:

On the outside of the sealed envelope containing the Itemized Bid Proposal and accompanying documentation as specified on the Bidders Checklist.

EACH PROPOSAL MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A DEPOSIT IN THE AMOUNT OF 5% OF THE TOTAL BID AMOUNT (GROSS SUM). SAID DEPOSIT SHALL BE CONSIDERED A GUARANTEE THAT THE BIDDER WILL ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE COUNTY IF AWARDED TO SAID BIDDER. THE DEPOSIT SHALL BE MADE PAYABLE TO THE "OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET" AND SHALL BE IN THE FORM OF A DRAFT, CERTIFIED CHECK, OR BID BOND.
