Police seize Handguns in drug raid

On Tuesday January 19th, 2021, Members of the Broome County Special Investigations Unit Task Force executed a narcotics search warrant at 37 Doubleday St in the City of Binghamton. Investigators recovered:

- Approximately **3.7 pounds of Marihuana**
- 4 loaded handguns (illegally possessed)
- 2 high capacity magazines
- Handgun ammunition
- Approximately \$ 5,000 in suspected drug sale proceeds

Investigators charged **Keenan Johnson, Noah Johnson-Smith, Mason Johnson-Smith** and a 17 year-old male in the investigation. The 17 year-old male was charged with Criminal Possession of a Weapon 2nd, Criminal Possession of a Firearm, both Felonies and Obstructing Governmental Administration 2nd and Resisting Arrest (Misdemeanors). The 17 year-old was arraigned in Broome County Family Court.

Noah Johnson-Smith was processed and released with an appearance ticket, to appear in Binghamton City Court at a later date. Keenan Johnson and Mason Johnson-Smith were remanded to the custody of the Broome County Correctional Facility.

Arrestee #1: Keenan Johnson, 25, of Binghamton, NY

Charges filed on Keenan Johnson:

- Criminal Possession of a Weapon 2nd (sub 3) a class C Felony
 Criminal Possession of a Weapon 3rd (sub 1) a class D Felony
- Criminal Possession of Marihuana 3rd a class E Felony
- **Resisting Arrest** a class A Misdemeanor
- Obstructing Governmental Administration 2nd a class A Misdemeanor

Arrestee # 2: Mason Johnson-Smith, 18, Binghamton, NY

Charges filed on Mason Johnson-Smith:

- 2 counts Criminal Possession of a Weapon 2nd (sub 3) a class C Felony
- 2 counts Criminal Possession of a Weapon 3rd (sub 1) a class D Felony
- Criminal Possession of a Weapon 3rd (sub 3) a class D Felony
- 2 counts Criminal Possession of a Weapon 3rd (sub 8) a class D Felonv
- Criminal Possession of Marihuana 2nd a class D Felony
- **Resisting Arrest** a class A Misdemeanor
- Obstructing Governmental Administration 2nd a class A Misdemeanor

Arrestee #3: Noah Johnson-Smith, 19, Binghamton, NY

Charge filed on Noah Johnson-Smith:

Criminal Possession of Marihuana 3rd – a class E Felony
