







BROOME COUNTY SPECIAL INVESTIGATIONS UNIT TASK FORCE

PRESS RELEASE February 25, 2021

The Broome County Special Investigations Unit Task Force executed a narcotics search warrant today in the Town of Windsor. Kenneth H. Drumm, Jr. was arrested after Task Force investigators located crystal methamphetamine, a loaded sawed-off 20 gauge shotgun, digital scales and packaging materials used for weighing and packaging narcotics for sale. Drumm was also arrested for previously selling crystal methamphetamine to another person on three separate dates. The Task Force was assisted on scene by marked patrol units from the Broome County Sheriff's Office.

Drumm is currently being held at the Broome County Sheriff's Correctional Facility pending his arraignment tonight at the CAP arraignment court.

Charges: Three counts of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Fifth Degree, class D Felonies, Three counts of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Fifth Degree, class D Felonies, Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Seventh Degree, a class A Misdemeanor, two counts of Criminally Using Drug Paraphernalia in the Second Degree, class A Misdemeanors, Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Third Degree, a class D Felony and Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree, a class C Felony.

The Broome County Special Investigations Unit Task Force is comprised of members of the Broome County Sheriff's Office, the City of Binghamton Police Department, the Village of Johnson City Police Department and Village of Endicott Police Department.
