**PRESS RELEASE

The Broome County Special Investigations Unit Task Force executed a narcotics search warrant last Friday, March 5, 2021 at 161 Laurel Ave in the City of Binghamton. Terry L. McNerney, Jr. was arrested after Task Force investigators located approx. 64 grams of Fentanyl packaged for sale, approx. 24 grams of Crack Cocaine, 30 Suboxone sublingual strips, approx. 3 grams of Crystal Methamphetamine, a 12 gauge shotgun, digital scales and packaging materials used for weighing and packaging narcotics for sale.

McNerney, Jr. was arraigned by City of Binghamton Court Saturday morning and was remanded to the custody of the Broome County Sheriff's Correctional Facility without bail.

Arrestee: Terry L. McNerney, Jr., 50, of Binghamton, NY

Charges: Six counts of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree, class B Felonies, Two counts of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Fifth Degree, class D Felonies, Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Fourth Degree, a class A Misdemeanor and Two counts of Criminally Using Drug Paraphernalia in the Second Degree, class A Misdemeanors.

The Broome County Special Investigations Unit Task Force is comprised of members of the Broome County Sheriff's Office, the City of Binghamton Police Department, the Village of Johnson City Police Department and Village of Endicott Police Department.
