The Broome County Sheriff's Office is currently conducting an investigation regarding an incident involving an exchange of gun fire with a Town of Windsor man early this morning. At about 12:34 AM on June 3, 2021 deputies responded to an address on Cascade Valley Road in the Town of Windsor following a report of person who discharged a weapon towards a vehicle that was turning around near the end of a driveway of a residence on Cascade Valley Road, Town of Windsor. Upon arrival of uniformed personnel, they were confronted by male armed with a handgun. Deputies engaged in an exchange of gunfire and the male was struck by a projectile to the shoulder area. Sheriff's Office personnel immediately administered first aid and requested and ambulance to respond. The male was transported to Wilson hospital for treatment and evaluation. No one from the Sheriff's Office was injured during the incident. The New York State Police are assisting in the investigation. No further information will be released at this time due to active, ongoing investigation.
