## BROOME COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE PRESS RELEASE July 29<sup>th</sup>, 2021

The Broome County Sheriff's Office Detective Division has arrested Russell Vitanza, a 66-year-old male, from the Town of Binghamton. On July 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2021 Broome County Sheriff's Office Detectives executed a search warrant at Vitanza's Town of Binghamton residence. During the execution of the search warrant, multiple long guns, high capacity magazines, one handgun and various types of ammunition were secured as evidence. As result of this investigation Vitanza was charged with one (1) count of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree, three (3) counts of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree and one (1) count of Criminal Contempt in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree.

Vitanza was processed for arrest and remanded to the custody of the Broome County Sheriff's Correctional Facility by the CAP Court. Vitanza has since been released on bail.
