Endicott Man Charged with Multiple Felonies after 252g of Crack Cocaine Recovered in Town of Union

(TOWN OF UNION, NY) An Endicott man is facing multiple felonies after mushrooms, cash and 252 grams of crack cocaine with an estimated street value of \$15,000 were recovered during an investigation by the Broome County Special Investigations Unit Task Force (SIU).

On January 2, 2025, the SIU executed a search warrant at 3104 Buckingham Road in the Town of Union.

The target of the search warrant was Allen L. Hurt, age 58 of Endicott, NY, who was present during the execution of the warrant. During the search, the following items of evidence were located:

- 252 grams of Crack Cocaine
- Psilocybin Mushrooms
- Scale, packaging and cutting agent used for the distribution of narcotics
- Approximately \$1,100 of US currency

According to detectives familiar with the investigation, the crack cocaine recovered had an estimated street value of as much as \$15,000.



As a result of the search warrant, Allen L. Hurt was arrested and charged with:

- Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 1st Degree, a Class A1 Felony
- Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 3rd Degree, a Class B Felony
- Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 7th Degree, a Class A Misdemeanor
- Three (3) Counts of Criminally Using Drug Paraphernalia in the 2nd Degree, a Class A Misdemeanor

Allen was transported Central Arraignment Part Court and remanded to the Broome County Correctional Facility.

The Broome County Special Investigations Unit Task Force was assisted by members of the Broome County Sheriff's Strategic Response Group.

"Excellent work by our dedicated SIU investigators," said Sheriff Fred Akshar. "Our joint partnership and continued cooperation between local law enforcement agencies continues to produce tangible results for the communities we serve."

The Broome County Special Investigations Unit Task Force is comprised of the Broome County Sheriff's Office, the City of Binghamton Police Department, and the Village of Johnson City Police Department.
