SIU Task Force seizes ghost gun and fentanyl executing search warrant in Village of Endicott

(ENDICOTT, NY) An Endicott man is facing multiple felonies after fentanyl and a ghost gun were recovered during an investigation by the Broome County Special Investigations Unit Task Force (SIU).

On January 30th, 2025, the Broome County Special Investigations Unit Task Force executed a search warrant at 4 Fillmore Ave. left side apartment in the Village of Endicott.

During the search, the following items of evidence were located:

- 17 blue M/30 pressed Fentanyl Pills
- A quantity of Fentanyl
- A Digital Scale used to distribute Narcotics
- A 9mm Ghost Gun with a Loaded Magazine
- \$296.00 in US Currency



As a result of the search warrant, Nishan H. Iglesias, age 32 of Endicott, was arrested and charged with:

- Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 3rd Degree, a Class B Felony
- Criminal Possession of a Firearm, a Class E Felony
- Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 4th Degree, a Class A Misdemeanor
- Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 7th Degree, a Class A Misdemeanor
- Criminally Using Drug Paraphernalia in the 2nd Degree, a Class A Misdemeanor

The Broome County Special Investigations Unit Task Force was assisted by the Endicott Police Department Community Response Unit.

The Broome County Special Investigations Unit Task Force is comprised of the Broome County Sheriff's Office, the City of Binghamton Police Department, and the Village of Johnson City Police Department.
