## BROOME COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE PRESS RELEASE

On January 6th 2023, around 5:45 am, Broome County Sheriff's Deputies responded to Leekville Rd. in Glen Aubrey, Town of Nanticoke, for a domestic dispute involving a firearm.

Responding deputies were advised of a male inside the residence, who had fired a round through the wall of the residence. Deputies arrived on scene and located the male inside still armed with a weapon. The suspect, Shawn Sabo, 30 years old, complied with commands to disarm and was detained without incident.

The subsequent investigation revealed Sabo had been involved in a physical domestic dispute inside the residence when he armed himself with a shotgun and threatened to harm himself. Subsequently, he fired a round from the shotgun into an exterior wall of the residence, which went through the wall and exited outside.

Shawn was transported to the sheriff's office for processing and ultimately to Central Arraignment before a magistrate. He was charged with the following crimes:

- 8 counts of Reckless Endangerment in the first degree, a Class D Felony
- 3 counts of Endangering the Welfare of a child 3, a Class A Misdemeanor

There were no injuries stemming from the incident.
