BCSO and Family Continue Seeking Answers in Vestal Man's Disappearance

Family Offers \$20,000 for Information Leading to Man's Whereabouts

(TOWN OF DICKINSON, NY) Investigators and family members of a missing Vestal man are still seeking answers to help locate Adib "Eddie" Rouhana, who been missing since January of this year.

Eddie Rouhana, 69 yrs. old of Vestal, was last seen on Saturday, January 11, 2025 around Noon at his place of business, Cars-R-US, located at 1170 of Upper Front St. in the Town of Chenango. Cell phone records show his phone was last used later that same day.

On January 14th, Eddie's family reported him missing, with the Broome County Sheriff's Office actively investigating his disappearance for the past several months.

"As families gather together for the Thanksgiving holiday, the Rouhana family is still without answers," said Sheriff Fred Akshar. "Our team of detectives have done an extraordinary job following through on every lead, pouring through data, searching every avenue and utilizing every investigative tool available to find Eddie. Someone in this community knows more, and we need more information and assistance from the public to help find him. We renew our call to the community for any information to help us locate Mr. Rouhana and return him to his loved ones."

The Rouhana family is offering a \$20,000 reward for any information that leads directly to Eddie Rouhana's whereabouts.

The family is seeking information that will lead to closure of this case.
