## **BROOME COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE PRESS RELEASE**

Windsor Man Faces Felony Charges After Being Tracked Down in the Snow by BCSO Road Patrol

(TOWN OF CHENANGO, NY) A Windsor man is facing felony charges after attempting to break into a residence and being tracked down in the snow by Broome County Sheriff's in the Town of Chenango.

On Tuesday, December 9, 2025 at approximately 6:00 PM, Broome County Sheriff's Road Patrol responded to a burglar alarm at a residence on Russell Road in the Town of Chenango.

Upon arrival, responding members noticed that the back door of the residence appeared to have been forced open. BCSO Road Patrol cleared the inside of the residence before patrolling the exterior of the home, at which point they found footprints in the snow that appeared to have come from the nearby creek on the north side of the home.

Following the tracks, members of the BCSO Road Patrol eventually came upon Scott A. Evanchof, age 42 of Windsor, NY in the nearby area. Evanchof's boots matched the boot prints leading from the creek, and Evanchof admitted to investigators that he had attempted to break into the residence.

Following a full investigation Scott A. Evanchof was charged with:

- Burglary in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree, a Class C Felony
- Criminal Mischief in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree, a Class E Felony

Evanchof was arraigned at Central Arraignment Part and released with an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Chenango Court at a later date.
