Broome County Undersheriff Sam Davis Graduates from the 292nd FBI National Academy

(QUANTICO, VA) The Broome County Sheriff's Office proudly congratulates Broome County Undersheriff Sam Davis upon his graduation from the FBI National Academy in Quantico, Virginia.

On Thursday, December 12, 2024, Undersheriff Davis joined 256 other law enforcement officers in completing 11 weeks of advanced communication, leadership and fitness training as part of the 292nd session of the FBI National Academy. The class consisted of men and women from 48 states, the District of Columbia and Guam and included members of law enforcement agencies from 27 counties, eight military organizations and five federal civilian organizations.

Internationally known for its academic excellence, the FBI National Academy requires participants to have proven records as professionals within their agencies to attend. On average, these officers have 21 years of law enforcement experience and usually return to their agencies to serve in executive-level positions.

“The Broome County Sheriff's Office could not be prouder of Undersheriff Davis and his achievement,” said Sheriff Fred Akshar. “This outstanding achievement and well-deserved honor adds yet another bright mark to Sam's already stellar law enforcement career. The unparalleled training and experience he's gained these past 11 weeks will unquestionably benefit and help strengthen our agency's ability to serve and protect the people of Broome County.”

FBI Academy instructors, special agents, and other staff with advanced degrees provide the training; many instructors are recognized internationally in their fields.

A total of 55,797 graduates have completed the FBI National Academy since it began in 1935. The National Academy is held at the FBI Training Academy in Quantico, the same facility where the FBI trains its new special agents and intelligence analysts.
