Florida Man Arrested on Weapons Charges Following Domestic Incident in Endicott

(TOWN OF DICKINSON) A Florida man is facing multiple charges following a firearms-related incident in the Village of Endicott.

On Tuesday, November 26, 2024 at approximately 8:09 AM, Broome County Sheriff's Office patrols responded to a report that the Endicott Police Department were searching for a male suspect who had pointed a handgun at a female on Madison Avenue in the Village of Endicott before fleeing the scene in a red Dodge Caravan.

A short time later, Broome County Sheriff's Deputies located the vehicle traveling north on Glenwood Road in the Town of Dickinson and conducted a traffic stop.

The driver, Jack A. Hawe, age 62 of Zephyrhills, FL, was found to have a loaded Glock model 43X 9mm pistol tucked into his waistband at the time of the traffic stop. Additional ammunition was found in the vehicle.

Following the investigation, Jack A. Hawe, a was charged with:

- Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2nd Degree, a Class C Felony
- Criminal Possession of a Firearm, a Class E Felony
- Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 4th Degree, a Class A Misdemeanor.

Hawe was processed on the above charges by the Broome County Sheriff's Office before being turned over to the Endicott Police Department for processing on charges related to their initial investigation. Hawe was then returned to the Broome County Correctional Facility and arraigned on all charges at Central Arraignment Part.
