## **BROOME COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE PRESS RELEASE**

Four arrested after Big Dipper 2 Burglary

(CONKLIN, NY) Two Conklin men and two juveniles are facing multiple charges following an investigation into a burglary at the Big Dipper BBQ 2 restaurant in Conklin.

On Saturday, April 19, 2025 at approximately 8:04 AM, Broome County Sheriff's Office deputies responded to a burglary complaint at the Big Dipper BBQ 2 restaurant on Conklin Rd. in the Town of Conklin. Upon arriving to open the business for the day, one of the owners had found evidence of a break in, with a window air-conditioning unit broken and moved, along with ice cream left on the floor.

Review of security footage from 12:52 AM that morning showed four individuals involved in the break in causing several thousands of dollars' worth of damage to the door and air conditioning unit of the businesses. Several tubs of ice cream and bottles of soda were taken by the suspects and a chest freezer was also left open, with ice cream found on the floor of the business. A total of twenty-two 5-gallon tubs of ice cream were reportedly lost due to possible contamination by the suspects.

The subsequent investigation conducted by BCSO Detectives, which was aided by tips from community members, successfully identified and apprehended the four suspects involved.

As a result of the investigation, the following individuals were charged:

- Tracy L. Bryce, age 20 of Conklin, NY, was charged with Criminal Mischief in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree and Burglary in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree, Class D Felonies
- Jordan C. Wilson, age 20 of Conklin, NY, was Criminal Mischief in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree and Burglary in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree, Class D Felonies
- Two juveniles were each charged with one (1) count of Burglary in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree, a Class D Felony
