BROOME COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE PRESS RELEASE Marathon Man Facing Sexual Abuse Charges

(TOWN OF LISLE, NY) A Marathon man is facing a charges for sexual abuse following an investigation in the Town of Lisle.

On May 24, 2024, members of the Broome County Sheriff's Office responded to a report from a 14-year-old victim from the Town of Lisle regarding sexual contact by Marshal O. Morehouse, age 72 of Marathon, NY. Investigators worked with Child Protective Services to establish a safety plan and safe residence for the victim while the investigation took place.

Following an investigation into the incident, Morehouse turned himself in at the Broome County Sheriff's Office and was charged with:

- Two counts of Sexual Abuse in the 3rd Degree , Class B Misdemeanors
- Endangering the Welfare of a Child, a Misdemeanor

Morehouse was issued appearance tickets returnable to the Town of Lisle Court on June 17, 2024 at 7:00 PM.
