***SIU Press Release -Town of Dickinson Woman Faces
Felony Charges Following Search Warrant Execution***

(TOWN OF DICKINSON, NY) A Town of Dickinson woman is facing multiple drug and child endangerment charges after a search warrant execution found 34.9 grams of cocaine and other drug paraphernalia on Monday.

On June 1, 2026, members of the Broome County Special Investigations Unit Task Force executed a search warrant at the Hillside Inn located at 690 Old Front St. in the Town of Dickinson as well a vehicle associated with the case. During a search of the room and vehicle, the following items were located.

- Approximately 34.9 grams of cocaine
- Suboxone strips
- Narcotics packaging material
- Digital scale
- Cutting agent

The target of the search warrant, Jazmine R. Meade, age 26 of the Town of Dickinson, was living in the hotel room with her two children at the time. Following the investigation, Meade was charged with the following:

- Two (2) Counts of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 3rd Degree, Class B Felonies
- Two (2) Counts of Endangering the Welfare of a Child, Class A Misdemeanors

- Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 7th Degree, a Class A Misdemeanor
- Three (3) Counts of Criminally Using Drug Paraphernalia in the 2nd Degree, Class A Misdemeanors

A Child Abuse Hotline Report was completed and Child Protective Services was contacted for additional investigation.

The Broome County Special Investigations Unit Task Force is comprised of members of the Broome County Sheriff's Office, the Binghamton Police Department, and the Johnson City Police Department.

The Task Force was assisted on scene by the Broome County Sheriff's Office Highway Patrol Division.
