Stolen Vehicle Pursuit and Narcotics Arrest August 21, 2022

At approximately 04:20am on 8/21/22, a Sergeant of the Broome County Sheriff's Office observed a stolen vehicle from Syracuse, NY traveling south bound on Upper Front Street in the Town of Dickinson. The Sergeant attempted a traffic stop on the stolen vehicle which then fled from the scene. A pursuit ensued into the City of Binghamton, Town of Vestal, and back into the City of Binghamton where it was then terminated due to the reckless driving of the suspect and the population of the area.

A short time later, the Sergeant came upon a motor vehicle accident involving the stolen vehicle and another car at the intersection of Court Street and Water Street in the City of Binghamton. Two suspects were observed fleeing from the stolen vehicle. Morgan Schoonmaker, 26 years old of Syracuse, NY, was a passenger in the vehicle and was taken into custody as she fled. Corey Murry, 31 years old of Syracuse, NY, the operator of the stolen vehicle, was located in the area a short time later and was taken into custody. The motor vehicle accident resulted in non-life-threatening injuries.

Subsequent investigation revealed that within the stolen vehicle, Murry and Schoonmaker possessed quantities of Heroin, Cocaine, and Oxycodone pills. All controlled substances. Murry was found to have a suspended NYS permit and was on NYS Parole.
