Mohammad Rivers, age 47 of Johnson City, NY, was charged with Criminal Obstruction of Breathing/Blood Circulation and Assault in the 3rd Degree (With Intent to Cause Physical Injury), Class A Misdemeanors, following an investigation into a domestic dispute in the Town of Windsor.

Ross, age 35 of Whitney Point, NY, was charged with two (2) counts of Reckless Endangerment in the 1st Degree, and two (2) counts of Assault in the 2nd Degree (With Invent to Cause Physical Injury With a Weapon), all Class D Felonies, along with several traffic violations following an investigation into a motor vehicle accident in the Town of Triangle.

James J. Sheridan, age 59 of Binghamton, NY, was charged with Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 7th Degree, a Class A Misdemeanor, following a traffic stop in the City of Binghamton.

Ricki R. Stanton, Jr., age 44 of Lisle, NY, was charged with Criminal Contempt in the 2nd Degree, a Class A Misdemeanor, following an investigation into an Order of Protection violation in the Town of Fenton.

Brittney N. Terrell, age 23 of Port Crane, NY, was charged with Criminal Possession of Stolen Property in the 4th Degree, a Class E Felony, following an investigation into a stolen vehicle in the Town of Fenton.
