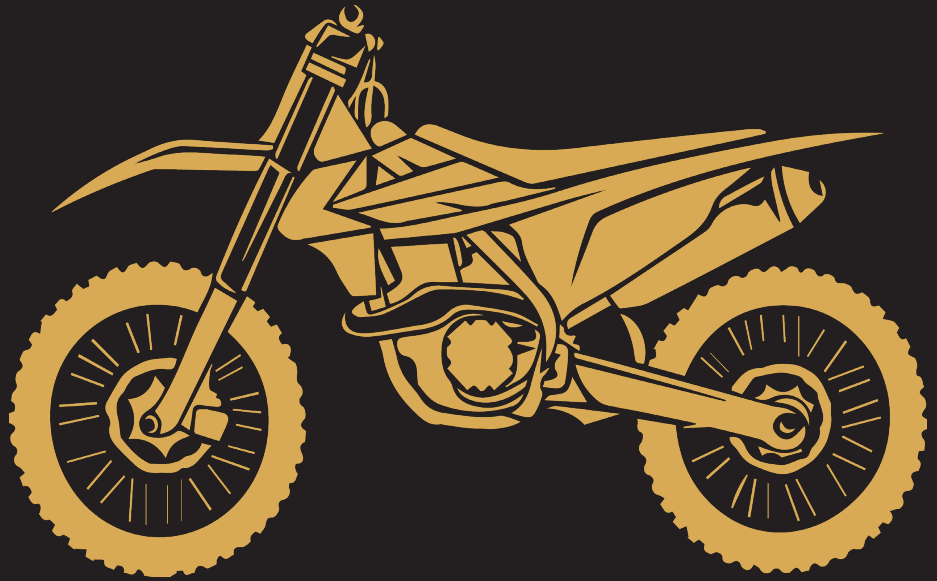




RIDING DIRTBIKES ON THE ROAD IS ILLEGAL PER NYS LAW

- ✓ No pedals
- ✓ Capable of 40+ MPH
- ✓ Designed for off-road use only
- ✓ **ILLEGAL** to ride in the street

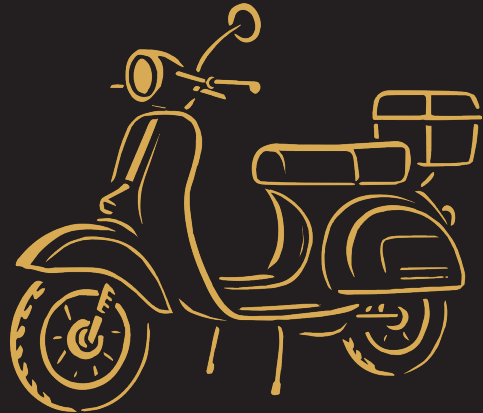
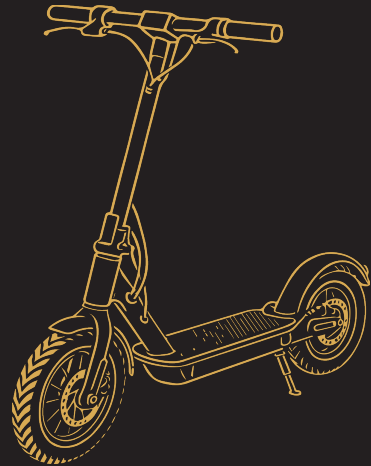

NYS GUIDELINES FOR BICYCLES WITH ELECTRIC ASSIST (E-BIKES), MOPEDS (LIMITED USE MOTORCYCLES) AND ELECTRIC SCOOTERS.



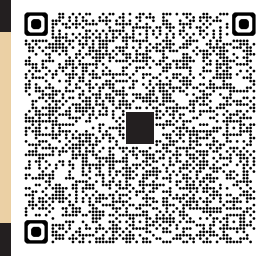

NOTE: Devices such as mopeds, electric skateboards, segways, hoverboards, and electric unicycles are not considered E-Bikes or E-Scooters and may be illegal to operate on the highways in New York State or subject to other laws or regulations.

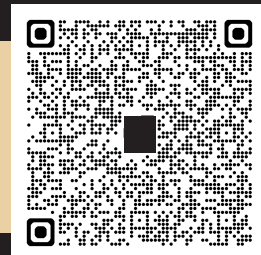

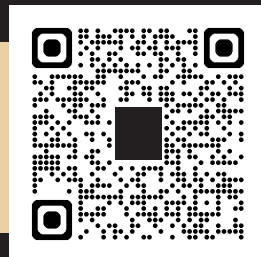
